



WATER CYCLE FUN

Supplies needed:

Recycled Rotisserie Chicken Container

Piece of Aluminum Foil

Water

Rock

Garden Hand Shovel

Grass with Soil and Roots

To create your own mini water cycle, add a rock to represent a mountain, grass for the vegetation, and a small pond made from aluminum foil and filled with water.

On a sunny day, the best way to power up the mini water cycle is to close the container and put it in the sun for several hours. As the water warms up, it evaporates and then condenses on the inside of the plastic lid. The water then “rains” on the environment inside the container and runs off the mountain to form little ponds.

This is an easy way to observe evaporation, transpiration, condensation, precipitation, and run off!
